



Study Room Policy

1. Please go to the Circulation Desk to sign out a study room.
2. Study rooms are first come, first served.
3. Study rooms cannot be reserved.
4. No food or drinks in the study rooms.
5. Study rooms can be used by a person or group for two hours per day.
6. Only four people to a study room.
7. The Library requests that all meetings conclude 15 minutes before the library closes.
8. There is no charge to use the study room; however, if the Library determines that special clean-up is required, a fee may be charged.
9. Children and youth groups must be adequately supervised by adults and must conform to the Oconee County Library Code of Conduct.
10. Patrons must be 18 or older to use the study room. However, patrons that are 12-17 can use the study room with parental/guardian consent.
